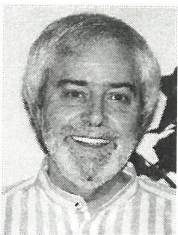

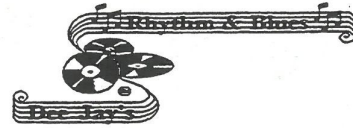

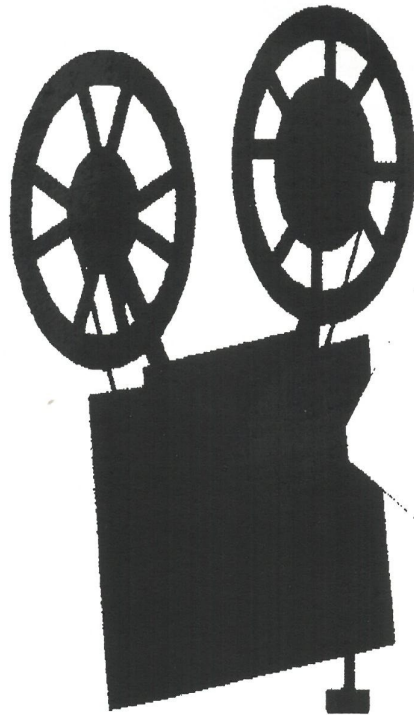

The Ethics Committee met and presents the proposed changes to the
Memphis Bop Club By Laws:

RESOLVED, that the By-Laws of Memphis Bop Club, Inc. be amended as follows:

(1) ARTICLE IX - "COMMITTEES," Section I. 7. is amended by deleting the words and symbol "Public Relations/".

(2) ARTICLE IX - "COMMITTEES," Section III - DUTIES OF STANDING COMMITTEES," ITEM F. is amended as follows:

(a) The words and symbol "PUBLIC RELATIONS/" are deleted.

(b) The first three numbered sentences are deleted.

(c) The numeral "4." which precedes the fourth numbered sentence is changed to "1."

(3) ARTICLE VI - "OFFICERS," Section III - "GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES OF OFFICERS," ITEM B, "THE VICE-PRESIDENT SHALL" is amended as follows:

(a) The first two numbered sentences deleted from Section III, Item F are set forth following the first numbered sentence, and are numbered "2" and "3."

(b) The third numbered sentence deleted from Section III, Item F is amended by deletion of the word "committee" and is set forth as numbered Sentence "4."

The sections referred to above, after these amendments have been made, shall read as follows:

ARTICLE IX-COMMITTEES

SECTION I - THERE SHALL BE THE FOLLOWING STANDING COMMITTEES:

7. Activities

SECTION III - DUTIES OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

F. ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE SHALL:

1. Be responsible for recommending, organizing, and coordinating all activities in support of club functions and/or projects.

ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

SECTION III - GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES OF OFFICERS:

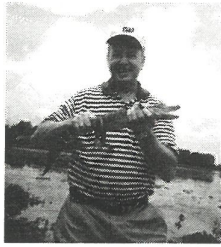
B. THE VICE-PRESIDENT SHALL:

1. Perform the duties of the president in the event of his/her absence or inability to perform his/her duties of office.

2. Be the Club contact point for charities.

3. Be responsible for coordinating the Club's participation in charitable activities selected by the Executive Board or membership.

4. Be responsible for promoting a positive image of the Club in the community and be the contact for non-charitable organizations who wish to request club participation in their Projects.
